In order for your child(ren) to receive transportation to and from Religious School, there are certain standards that must be met. It is essential that your child(ren) engage in self-discipline and individual responsibility of his/her actions. The Beth Judah Religious School Van Rules and Etiquette supports the right of each student to travel to and from Religious School in a calm, safe and secure environment.

The student will...

- 1. Arrive at the drop off location on time;
- 2. Follow directions of the van driver at all times;
- 3. Speak in a quiet voice, no yelling;
- 4. Use any hand-held games, ipods or cell phones only on vibrate or low volume so as not to disturb the driver or his/her fellow passengers;
- 5. Stay in his/her seat and use a seatbelt at all times;
- 6. Use appropriate language at all times.

The student will not...

- 1. Abuse his/her fellow students or teachers physically, mentally or spiritually;
- 2. Use profane language.

The parent will...

- 1. Make sure their child arrives at the drop off location on time;
- 2. Be at the pick up location on time;
- 3. Support the rules and etiquette of the Beth Judah Religious School van.

Severe Infractions

Any student found being abusive and/or disrespectful to the van driver and/or fellow passengers, using alcohol, illegal drugs, dangerous objects, stealing, vandalizing the van or engaging in physical assaults against other students or staff members will be removed from the van immediately. That student MAY NOT receive transportation for one year.
