



APPLICATION FOR REFUND OF PROVINCIAL FUEL TAX FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

under the Motor Fuel Tax Act

Program Information

- You may receive a refund of the provincial **motor fuel tax** on fuel you purchased in BC for use in one vehicle that you own or lease.
- The maximum refund amount for each calendar year is **\$500**. The ministry cannot issue a refund of less than \$10.
- A claim will not be processed if your application is incomplete and/or original fuel receipts are not submitted.
- Allow approximately four weeks for your refund to be processed (eight weeks during the peak period of January 1 to March 31).
- Your receipts will be returned, unless you indicate otherwise at the bottom of this page.

Step 1 Registration Information

Step 5 Fuel Purchase Information

- A claim must be received by the ministry within four years from the date shown on the fuel receipt. Any fuel receipts dated more than four years before the date the ministry receives your claim will be deducted.
- Each original fuel receipt must show the type of fuel purchased, the date the fuel was purchased, the number of litres purchased, and the seller's name and address.

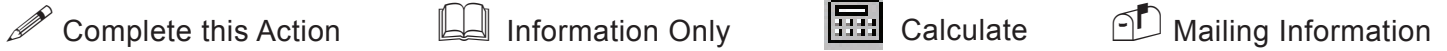

FOR COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION FOR REFUND OF PROVINCIAL FUEL TAX FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES FORM (FIN 472)



Step 1 Registration Information

- Enter your 6-digit registration number in the box provided.
- This is the number that was provided to you at the time you registered for the program.

Step 2 Claimant Information

- Enter your name, mailing address, city, province, postal code, daytime telephone number and e-mail address (if you have one).

Step 3 Vehicle Information

- Indicate either YES or NO to questions A and B.
- If you answered NO to question A and/or B, provide a brief explanation in the space provided.

Step 4 Claimant Declaration

- Review the claimant declaration and ensure you understand the consequences of supplying false information. Certify the declaration by including your name, date and signature.
- We will require a Power of Attorney if someone is signing on your behalf.
- Mail your completed application form along with your original fuel receipts to the address located at the top of the application form.

Step 5 Fuel Purchase Information

- A claim must be received by the ministry within four years from the date shown on the fuel receipt. Any fuel receipts dated more than four years before the date the ministry receives your claim will be deducted. It is recommended that you submit refund claims **once** a year.
- Original fuel receipts must be submitted with your refund claim, as the receipts provide proof of the amount of tax paid. Each fuel receipt must show the type of fuel purchased, the date the fuel was purchased, the number of litres purchased, and the seller's name and address.

Step 5 Fuel Purchase Information (continued)



To calculate the total litres of fuel purchased for a refund claim period:

- i) organize your original fuel receipts in date order, and
- ii) add the litres from each fuel receipt to calculate the total litres of fuel purchased.

Enter this amount in the **Litres of Fuel** column for the applicable refund claim period.

In the **Fuel Type** column, select (✓) the one type of fuel (gas, diesel, propane) that was purchased for use in your vehicle.

Please note: You cannot claim a refund on propane purchased after June 30, 2010.

In the **Area of Fuel Purchases** column, select (✓) the one area from where you purchased most of your fuel.

Determine if most of your fuel purchases were made in either the **South Coast BC Transportation Service Region** or the **Victoria Regional Transit Service Area**. To aid in making this determination, refer to the Transit Service Area section on Page 2 of the application form. If most of your fuel purchases were not made in either of these two areas, select (✓) **Other Areas of BC**.

Refer to the following for an example of how to complete Step 5 of the application form.

Example

A registrant in the program resides in Vancouver and owns a vehicle that uses gas. After organizing their original fuel receipts in date order and adding the litres of fuel indicated on each fuel receipt, the registrant calculates that between January 1, 2011 and December 31, 2011, the registrant purchased 503.5 litres of gas at service stations located in Vancouver and Burnaby.
