Dear Blair Township Residents:

Each year when we send out the water assessment installment bills we inevitably get calls from residents stating that their mortgage company pays their water assessment. The only way your assessment is paid by your mortgage company is: if you sent them your bill and asked them to pay it, they request the bill (which is usually the case), or it is rolled over onto your winter tax bill. If the latter statement is true then you are paying even more each year for your assessment, because if it is not paid by June 30th you continue to pay a 1% penalty on any late amount each month until we roll it over onto your winter tax bill at the beginning of November.

If you would like to have the mortgage company pay your water assessment, then please have them send us a letter requesting that we send the bill to them. We are happy to do this, but we need something in writing from them for our records to be able to do this. If you have any further questions please feel free to give myself or Lynette a call.

Construction on the improvements to the water system is slated to begin sometime in June. The township requested bids and at the bid opening on April 12, 2011 three contractors were selected. The bids for all three, underground storage tank, transmission line, and generator and controls came in lower than expected. The savings on these projects will allow us to paint the exterior of the elevated water tank and the interior if needed. We are also planning to complete several loops in the existing water system to make it more reliable and eliminate dead ends. This will all be done through a loan from Rural Development of 2.7 million dollars. The DEQ has been pushing us to get our fire flow ratings higher and with these improvements, that will be behind us. The sewer extension on East Silver Lake Road should wrap up soon with a few items yet to be resolved. If you have any questions or concerns please give me a call and I will try to address them.

Zoning Department Update

I hope everyone's summer is going well. I thought that since summer project season is now upon us I would give some information on frequently asked questions in regards to land use permits:

What is a Land Use Permit?

A Land Use Permit is something that authorizes a person or organization to enact a certain use of land or something that confirms that a proposed structure is in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Blair Township Zoning Ordinance. A Land Use Permit does not authorize construction if a building permit is required.

Why Does Blair Township Require a Land Use Permit?

Blair Township requires land use permits to ensure that uses of land and structures are compliant with the Zoning Ordinance.

When Do You Need a Land Use Permit?

Blair Township requires a Land Use Permit for the erection of. addition to, alteration or moving of any building or structure. Land Use Permits are also required for any activity or change of use and the grading, leveling, re-contouring of land or the removing of trees in connection with the above mentioned activities.
