Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995

To be eligible for the issue of up to 20 Low Volume VINs (LVVs) in a calendar year, you must complete this form and provide:

- proof of manufacture of the trailer, including make/model/month and year of build (for example, manufacturer receipt; or for homemade trailers, a declaration stating the name and address of the person who built the trailer including the build date of the trailer)
- Evidence of Identity (EOI). Refer to the separate Evidence of Identity Information Sheet (F4362) or www.tmr.qld.gov.au for requirements.
