- The Child Support Limited License is granted only for operating Class D vehicles and for a maximum of 90 days.
The permitted driving time cannot exceed 60 hours and a maximum of 6 days per week.
If the address on this application does not match the address on your Minnesota driver's license, attach a Duplicate License Change of Address form.
