Use of the Power of Attorney

The *Power of Attorney Form* must be filled out, signed and dated by an individual who cannot go in person (mandator) to the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ) and who wants to authorize another person (mandatary) to conduct, on their behalf, a transaction in connection with their record. Once completed, the power of attorney contains confidential information that could be used for other purposes, which is why the SAAQ recommends only giving a power of attorney to someone you trust and keeping a copy of the document.

General instructions

- A power of attorney form that is not completed in accordance with the instructions or on which entries have been erased, crossed out or altered will not be accepted.
- In the "MANDATOR" part of Section 1, the person being represented must provide the mandatory with an original copy of a piece of identity accepted by the SAAQ¹ if the person chooses to enter the date of birth. No piece of identity is required if the person chooses to enter the Québec driver's licence reference number.
- A fax or copy of a duly completed form can be accepted only if the required signature(s) is/are original.
- The mandatary (person representing the mandator) must be age 18 or older and will have to provide one piece of identification accepted by the SAAQ¹.
- Vehicle registered as co-owned or jointly-leased: For any transaction other than an ownership transfer of a vehicle, one of the persons whose name appears as co-owner or co-lessee on the registration certificate must come in person or provide a power of attorney. Contact the SAAQ to find out the requirements that apply to the transfer of ownership of this type of vehicle².

Additional instructions concerning vehicle transfer

If you give power of attorney because:

You are **selling** or **giving** away your vehicle:

- Complete and sign sections 1, 2 and 3A.
- Remember that you are still responsible for the vehicle until it is registered in the new owner's name. It is your responsibility to ensure that the registration was put under the new owner's name.

You are acquiring a vehicle:

- Complete and sign sections 1, 2 and 3B.
- If the acquirer is absent, the transfer transaction will be refused to the mandatary if the odometer reading reported in section 3B is less than what was declared for the previous registration. The acquirer can then ask the transfer for explanations or go in person to authorize the SAAQ to proceed with the transfer if the acquirer still wishes to do so.

Also:

- Before making the transfer, check if the vehicle can be registered by calling 1 900 565-1212 or using the Check if a Vehicle Can be Registered online service on the SAAQ Web site at www.saaq.gouv.qc.ca. Fees are charged for each consultation.
- To give away or sell a vehicle registered in Québec between related individuals, both parties must submit:
 - √ The Declaration of a Transaction Between Related Individuals with Regard to a Road Vehicle Registered in Québec (VD-80.1-V) form by Revenu Québec, duly completed.
 - ✓ A document proving the kinship².
- 1. Original pieces of identification accepted by the SAAQ.
 - Licence authorizing the operation of a vehicle
 - Examination identity card issued by the SAAQ
 - Certificate of Canadian citizenship with photo
- Permanent Resident Card
- Passport
- Certificate of Indian Status card
- Health Insurance Card
- Taxi driver's permit
- Peace officer's identity card
- Canadian Armed Forces Identity Card
