Appendix A: Acceptable Forms of Identification

As part of the application process, the Royal Canadian Mint requires that all individuals provide either:

a) A copy (front and back) of a valid government issued driver's license;

<u>OR</u>

b) A copy of a valid piece of government issued identification <u>AND</u> a copy of a recent utility bill containing occupant's address for verification purposes.

To be considered "valid", the ID must not be expired. Documentation must also be government issued to be considered as "acceptable". Please find below a list of ID considered acceptable:

- Passport
- Driver's license
- Birth certificate issued by a provincial/territorial government (e.g. church issued birth certificates will not be accepted)
- Record of Landing
- Permanent Resident Card
- Old Age Security Card
- Certificate of Indian Status
- Provincial Health Card *

^{*}Health cards issued in the province of Manitoba, Ontario or Prince Edward Island are not considered an acceptable form of government issued ID. Also note that we do not ask for, or require, customers to provide health cards issued from the province of Quebec, as per legislative requirements. Customers are in no way obligated to provide a health card issued from Quebec as a means of identification.
