RECORD YOUR MILEAGE DURING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER



You get SPURS points for each mile you run from October 1st to November 1st. To report your mileage you can email me at timothyhood@hotmail.com, post your miles on snailspacegroup.com, report to me at Monday and Wednesday runs, or leave me a message at 714-969-8594. You can even mail me your mileage at 919 Alabama St. Huntington Beach, Ca. 92648 (somebody has to fund Bob Norton's pension).



When posting mileage give me your name, total miles so far and miles accrued since your last report. To get maximum points you must report your mileage to me at least 6 times. Maximum points are 300 plus some bonuses. 150 miles max will be counted and give you 300 SPURS points. In order to be eligible to win glassware you must report 8 times total. Cool awards for the first people to 150 miles.
