2013/2014 SCHOOL YEAR CALENDAR Prairie Spirit School Division's 2013/14 school year calendar is currently being developed and is expected to be finalized in April, 2013. Once the calendar has been approved by the Prairie Spirit Board of Education and the Ministry of Education, it will be published throughout the Division. The Ministry of Education requires that all school divisions post their school calendars by May 1 each year.
