The Fayette County Board of Education (FCBOE) Purchasing Office is requesting pricing for endpoint security software for computer terminals as described in this Request for Quotes (RFQ).

The intent of this quotation is to secure pricing for endpoint security software for a term of one year beginning in August 2014 with possible renewals for two additional years. Solutions should utilize the current configuration on endpoint devices and not separate appliance[s].

It is the proposer's responsibility to include all elements of pricing in the total cost. No additional charges may be added to the cost quoted, i.e. shipping, courier, setup, material increase, etc. The Fayette County Board of Education expects all pricing to be final for the period of the term listed above. Any proposer failing to meet the General and Special Terms and Conditions may be excluded from this RFQ.

General Terms & Conditions

- 1. Quotes are to be construed as the completely assembled delivery price unless otherwise specified (F.O.B. Destination).
- 2. Responders are required to provide three (3) references on the form provided within this RFQ.
- 3. Delivery time should be quoted as the number of business days after the receipt of order (ARO) for delivery to the location requested.
- 4. Unless otherwise stated, brand names are listed for reference purposes. Comparable items may be considered, provided they meet or exceed the specifications set forth in this RFQ. When quoting goods other than specified in this RFQ, include a complete description consisting of: manufacturer name, manufacturer's item number and a copy of the manufacturer's specifications for the alternate item. In the event a comparable item is given, the FCBOE reserves the right to make the final determination on what is the best solution.
- 5. Responders providing a quote must include a current e-verify affidavit as provided in this RFQ.
- 6. DO NOT INCLUDE TAX. Public schools are exempt.
- 7. The Fayette County Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all
