The two applications will be considered separately. The success of an application for equivalencies, granted at the discretion of the relevant faculty, school or institute, is dependent on the decision of the Espace administratif des Etudiants regarding the enrollment.
- The following documents must be submitted together with the application for equivalencies: - a CV
 - a letter of motivation
 - A copy of each of the following official documents is also required:
 - study plan
 - description of training
 - weekly schedule, number of semesters
 - transcript of examination grades and credits earned
 - diploma(s)
 - grading scales and/or diploma supplement
 - bachelor/master thesis (memoir) (for applicants who have written one)

Please also comply with any instructions particular to the degree applied for (see <u>www.unige.ch</u>). Applicants for a doctorate must consult the instructions of the relevant faculty.

- Official documents in a language other than English, French, German, Italian or Spanish must be accompanied by a French version prepared by an official translator, otherwise by a translation into any of the other aforementioned languages.
- Incomplete or late applications for equivalencies will not be considered, and the University will not enter into correspondence with such applicants.

Copies of documents required for both the application for equivalencies and the enrollment application must be submitted twice
